1. Complete the attached Non-Degree application and obtain approval from the appropriate faculty advisor. (The application can be completed online, but must be printed out and submitted to the Office of Graduate Admissions after a faculty advisor has approved your application. The application **must** be accompanied by an official or unofficial transcript demonstrating a proof of bachelor's degree).
2. Submit your completed Non-Degree Application to the appropriate Office of Graduate Admissions (see above) and pay the \$75 non-refundable application fee. (The application fee can only be paid by check, money order, or cash.) If paying by cash, please pay at the Bursar's window and attach a copy of the receipt to your application.
3. See your faculty advisor on the day assigned for new non-degree students to have your course(s) approved and your registration entered into the system, (Check the CCNY website at www.ccny.cuny.edu/registrar for the registration schedule).
4. Log onto your CUNYfirst account and select "semester Bill" from the menu, click on the semester you wish to pay and, when you are ready to make your payment, click on the "pay Now" tab at the bottom.
5. Obtain a City College Identification Card. Please show a copy of your semester bill to the ID office (NAC 1/204) for your picture identification. It is mandatory to show your ID to the security guard when entering any CCNY buildings.
6. New York State Public Health Law 2165 mandates that all incoming students born after December 31, 1956, must be immunized against measles, mumps, and rubella. Students need to submit their **immunization records** before registering for classes. All students (**regardless of age**) must complete the **meningitis response form**. You may fax your records to (212) 650-8227, mail them or hand them in. You may call Student Health Services at (212) 650-8222 to confirm that your fax was received. Even if you mail or fax your records, please be sure to bring a copy of this important information with you on the day of registration.

Important Information

As of February 1, 1999, Graduate Non-Degree students are limited to a maximum of 9 credits for the School of Education, 12 credits for the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, and 6 credits for the School of Engineering while in attendance at CCNY. No exceptions or exemptions are granted beyond the maximum allowance. In order to continue beyond the maximum allowed credits, students must apply for matriculation.

1. The School of Architecture, Branding + Integrated Communication, Computer Science MIS, Digital and Interdisciplinary Art Practice, Media Arts Production, Mental Health Counseling, and the Public Service Management programs **do not permit non-degree students**.
2. Education students who are planning to matriculate must take the New York State Teacher Certification Examination (NYSTCE) of the Academic Literacy Skills Test (ALST formally LAST) before completion of the 9 credit maximum as a non-degree student.
